



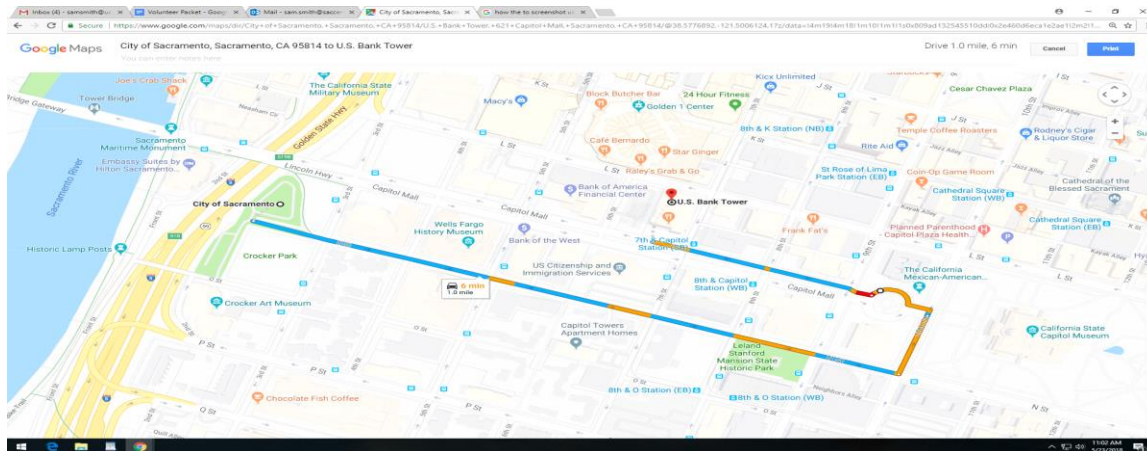
## Parade Marchers

## **Safety tips and advice**

### Parade March Safety Procedures

Pride Committee members, parade volunteers, and Sac PD will assist in directing traffic. All parade entries must follow directions from pride organizers and sac police:

- All vehicle drivers must drive slowly and use caution to avoid injuring any parade participants or spectators.
- Vehicle speed limit: 15 mph maximum
- All vehicle drivers must have a clear 180-degree view before entering the parade route.
- No alcohol can be consumed while participating in the parade
- Non one is allowed to throw candy or other articles from parade vehicles at any time. If Center staff or parade volunteers observe any entry throwing articles from parade vehicles, report the name of the entry to the Operations Manager. The entrant will be billed a minimum of \$100 for violating this policy.
  - If you have obtained permission from the Pride Director, you will be allowed
- Only parade entries with advance permission from the Pride Director who may have paid the distribution fee may hand promotional items to spectators along the parade route.
- Participants with permission to distribute must go to the spectators and not create a situation where the spectators are running into the street to get the article.
- Sac police officers will be present along the entire route of the parade. In case of an emergency, contact officers immediately who will summon emergency services as needed.

### Preventative Measures

These FESTIVAL RULES are posted at all gates. Our festival rules are based on similar rules used at other major events.

### Rules of Pride

- All bags, containers and packages are subject to search.
- No coolers allowed.
- NO OUTSIDE ALCOHOL ALLOWED.
- Only factory-sealed, non-alcoholic beverages allowed. No open beverage containers allowed. No glass containers. This includes water bottles.
- Guests will not be allowed to carry alcoholic beverages through the exit gates.
- No weapons of any type allowed.

- No marijuana use allowed.
- No bicycles or unicycles.
- Pets should be left at home for their comfort and safety.
- Respect all festival staff, volunteers, and other festival goers

-In the event Protesters Disrupt the Parade March -

- The Parade March Manager, Pride Director, and The Center Executive Director should be notified by phone and radio immediately of any disruption of the parade
- This team will decide if it is necessary to activate the contingency route. This team in coordination with Sac police department will determine the best way to effectively respond to protesters and to resume the parade without further incident.
- The Center respects everyone's First Amendment rights to free speech and to peacefully protest. The Free Speech Corner is available for any protesters who wish to protest peacefully.
- Please do not engage in verbal confrontations, and do not physically engage the protesters.
