


Renewing Your SVPA Membership

(in time for SVPA's 2023 Conference)

In preparation for the upcoming SVPA 2023 Fall Conference, “**From Recovery To Triumph: Healing In The Pandemic Era**,” we need to make sure your membership is current so you do not have to pay the non-member registration fee amount. In addition to attending the conference at a discounted rate, your active SVPA membership gives you access to our monthly newsletter and event emails (including Action Alerts), and discounted registration for the other events we plan to host during the year. *So renew your membership now so you can save money and attend all the upcoming exciting SVPA events!*

If you are uncertain of whether your membership is current, log in to the SVPA website. After logging in, you can select “**View profile**” to see the status of your membership (see below).
